Purpose

The purpose of the "Catawba Team Basketball Camp" is to give high school teams and their coaches the opportunity to improve and prepare for the upcoming season. The teams will play at least ten games plus a tournament on Wednesday. Coaches will also have time to practice with their teams.

Facilities

Use the \$5 million facilities of Abernethy Physical Education Center. It contains Goodman Gymnasium, which has three full-size basketball courts. Goodman Gym is the home of Catawba College's Indians. The center also features a full-size indoor pool and classrooms for meetings. 90% of all camp games are played on campus on full-size courts. All of our dorms are now air conditioned. Overflow housing is in a local hotel.

Camp Directors

The camp will be directed by coaches JIM BAKER and BILL HAGGERTY.

Baker, a 1978 graduate of Catawba, returned to Catawba in June, 1993, following fifteen years of assistant coaching experience on the collegiate level. He has directed camps at Belmont Abbey, Davidson, Virginia Tech, and VMI. Baker started and successfully conducted team camps at Davidson and Virginia Tech. Baker's record at Catawba is 286 & 156. Catawba won conference championships in '96, '98, '01, '05, '07 and tournament championships in '98, '99, '01, '04, '08, & '09. Catawba has played in seven of the last ten NCAA tournaments.

Haggerty, also a graduate of Catawba, first rebuilt the women's program at Catawba. He produced their first winning season in twelve years in 1985-1986 by going 17-15. He became coach Sam Moir's assistant in August 1987 and has continued in the same capacity since. Haggerty has helped to build Catawba's Individual and Team Camps into one of the finest summer camp programs in the region.

NOTE: Each coach will be hired as an "Independent Contractor" and will be issued a 1099 Misc. Form from Catawba College.

NOTE: Eight players per team is recommended in order to avoid fatigue and to cover any injuries to squad members. For each team, there must be a coach. If you desire to coach more than one of your teams, that is acceptable, or you can split duties with your assistant.

Housing and Meals

Boarding campers will be housed in the college dormitories with counselor and coaches' supervision. You must provide your own linens (sheets, pillow, pillowcase) for single beds, towels and personal toilet articles, as well as appropriate attire for camp participation, including a swimsuit. Balanced meals will be served in the college cafeteria. Overflow housing is in a local hotel.

Health Care & Insurance

Qualified sports medicine specialists will be available at all times to treat athletic injuries. Players can receive treatment at all sessions and taping will be available, if tape is supplied. Each participant will be covered by secondary insurance while attending the camp. The insurance provides coverage secondary to the individual's family policy. Individual responsible for amount of deductible.

NOTE: A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION IS REQUIRED FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS. BRING THE DOCTOR'S EXAMINATION REPORT ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE CAMP SESSION.

Time of Arrival

Campers should arrive on Sunday morning, between 9 and 11 a.m. Registration and room assignments will be made upon your arrival. The Dining Hall will serve the evening meal on Sunday, and all teams will play their first two games that day. Teams will meet at 11:30 a.m. Coaches will meet at 11:30. Please be on time!

TIME OF DEPARTURE: The camp will end on Wednesday afternoon, following tournaments.

Costs

Per player - \$265.00 for boarding camper (A non-refundable deposit of \$25 from each player is due by May 15, 2010. After June 1, a late fee of \$5 per player will be charged.) The day camp rate is \$175.00

A refundable \$10 room key deposit and a \$5 dorm damage is

required of all campers. (The total amount of all deposits is \$15.00). The entire \$15 will be refunded if key is returned, meal card returned, and there is no room or community dorm damage.

Please call as soon as possible to reserve space for your team. When you call, please give us an approximate number of players you will bring and also the league or leagues you will be playing in during camp. The league and number can be changed up to $\underline{1}$ week before camp begins. Please tell us when you will be mailing in your players applications and deposit. We will hold your space. If the majority of deposits have not been received from you prior to May 15, your team's space will be forfeited. Please encourage your players to turn it in to you and mail their applications and deposits A.S.A.P. Space is limited . ★ "POSITION PLAY CAMP FOR POINTS, WINGS & POST" ★ June 17-19, 2010

Catawba coaches will conduct the area's only "Position Play Camp for Points, Wings & Post," June 17-19. The camp is designed for post players and guards who seek to learn how to play their positions to the best of their abilities. The camp is for the more advanced player and those wanting to prepare themselves for men's college play. For three days and two nights the players will undergo an intense and highly specialized training camp.

The camp will spend the majority of time in teaching and repetition.

Players will be divided into small groups for instruction with emphasis on the development of individual skills. The camp will be conducted similar to a college practice.

The cost of each camp is \$195.00 (2 per room). This fee includes room and board, insurance, t-shirt, and instruction. A physical examination is required and a \$25.00 non-refundable deposit. Also, the cost of the "Position Play Camp" is only \$150.00 (4 per room) if you attend the "Team Camp".
